Ordinance relating to the building of sidewalk on Main and Mt. Vernon Street in Nixa, Missouri.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Nixa as follows:

Section 1. That a certain sidewalk to be built along and on the west and east side of Main street and along and on the north and south side of Mt. Vernon Streets in the Village of Nixa, Missouri and on the property hereinafter described.

That said sidewalk will be built on the east end of Lot No. 1012 on Main Street in the Village of Nixa, Mo., which is owned by Geo. Ball.

That said sidewalk will be built on the east end of Lot No. 1015 on Main Street in the Village of Nixa, Mo., which is owned by Mrs. Sabra Goss.

That said sidewalk will be built on the west end of Lot No. 1831 on Main Street in the Village of Nixa, Mo., which is owned by J.J. Herndon.

That said sidewalk will be built on the west end of Lot No. 1832 on Main Street in the Village of Nixa, Missouri, which is owned by Mrs. Frances Herndon.

That said sidewalk will be built on the west end of Lot No. 1850 on Main Street in the Village of Nixa, Mo., which is owned by L.L. Bayer.

That said sidewalk will be built on the west end of Lot No. 1851 on Main Street in the Village of Nixa, Mo., which is owned by the Nixa Christian Church.

That said sidewalk will be built on the south end of Lot No. 1212 on Mt. Vernon Street in the Village of Nixa, Mo. which is owned by W.A. Meadows.

That said sidewalk will be built on the south end of Lot No. 1209 on Mt. Vernon Street in the Village of Nixa, Mo., which is owned by Mrs. Hettie Porter.

That said sidewalk will be built on the south end of Lots 1208 and part of 1209 on Mt. Vernon Street in the Village of Nixa, Missouri, which is owned by A. Stiffler.

That said sidewalk will be built on the north end of Lots No.s, pt of 1826 and all of Lots No.s. 1827, 1828 and 1829 on Mt. Vernon Street in the Village of Nixa, Mo., which is owned by L.W. Dunham and J.C. Taylor.

That said sidewalk will be built on the north end of Lot No. 1824 on Mt. Vernon Street in the Village of Nixa, Mo., which is owned by A.J. Darr.

That said sidewalk will be built on the north end of Lot No. 1825 on Mt. Vernon Street in the Village of Nixa, Mo., which is owned by W.E. Keltner and H.T. Nokes.

That said sidewalks is to be four feet in width and to be built of the depth of 4 inches and the material shall consist of one part cement and five parts gravel or chat and one part sand.

That said owners herein named shall be given notice in writing at least fifteen days before the time to build and construct said sidewalk that they may build the sidewalk according to the specifications here in this ordinance along and in front of his or her lot or lots herein described.

That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Board of Trustees.
