The above was the decision reached by taking the total valuation of city then dividing by the total number of tax payers plus the present tax levy of \$1.55 on the \$100.00 valuation.

It was a unanimous decision by the Board of Aldermen that the?????? Plant be charged for license at the rate of \$5.00 per year.
