**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
NIXA, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE
BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP GRANT THROUGH THE U.S.
DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE**

WHEREAS, ARTICLE II, Section 2.1 of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Nixa, Missouri provides the City of Nixa all powers of the General Assembly of the State of Missouri have authority to confer upon any City, provided such powers are consistent with the Constitution of the state of Missouri and are not limited or denied by the City of Nixa's Charter or by statute; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Nixa, Missouri, recognizes the importance of the pursuit of grant opportunities that support police officer safety and public safety priorities; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Nixa, Missouri, believes the best interests of the community would be served by accepting the Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant from the Bureau of Justice Assistance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NIXA, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. The City of Nixa Police Department is hereby authorized to accept a grant award for the amount of \$5,225.28.00 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Department of Justice Assistance, Bulletproof Vest Partnership. These funds will be used for reimbursement for up to 50% of the costs for the purchase of bulletproof vests.

Section II. All ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
