Subject: Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Activities Grant

The Missouri Police Chiefs Charitable Foundation, in conjunction with the Missouri Department of Public Safety and the Office of Homeland Security, has secured funding to allow approximately 6,200 Missouri law enforcement officers to receive online training. Approved agencies are required to have all their officers complete six-(6) mandatory courses by August 31, 2020. Upon completion of the mandatory courses, the costs of individual officer memberships for Virtual Academy will be covered by this grant. Currently, we pay approximately \$ 3,200 per year for access to online Virtual Academy training for our officers. This grant would cover those costs for fiscal year 2020. This is a non-matching grant.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-114**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NIXA, MISSOURI,  
AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION AND/OR ACCEPTANCE OF THE LAW  
ENFORCEMENT TERRORISM PREVENTION ACTIVITES GRANT THROUGH  
THE MISSOURI POLICE CHIEFS CHARITABLE FOUNDATION**

**WHEREAS**, ARTICLE II, Section 2.1 of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Nixa, Missouri provides the City of Nixa all powers of the General Assembly of the State of Missouri have authority to confer upon any City, provided such powers are consistent with the Constitution of the state of Missouri and are not limited or denied by the City of Nixa’s Charter or by statute; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of Nixa, Missouri considers officer safety and training to be a priority mission; and

**WHEREAS**, the Missouri Police Chief Charitable Foundation, in conjunction with the Missouri Department of Public Safety and the Office of Homeland Security offers a non-matching grant program for Missouri law enforcement officers to receive online training, including Virtual Academy; and

**WHEREAS**, approved agencies are required to have all their officers complete six (6) mandatory courses by August 31, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of Nixa, Missouri, believes the best interests of the public would be served by making a grant application with the Missouri Police Chiefs Charitable Foundation to cover the costs for access to online Virtual Academy training for our officers.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NIXA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section I:** The City of Nixa, Missouri, shall make an application and if awarded, accept a grant under the terms and conditions of the Missouri Police Chiefs Charitable Foundation, in conjunction with the Missouri Department of Public Safety and the Office of Homeland Security and shall enter into and agree to the understandings and assurances in said application;

**Section II:** The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute such documents and all other documents necessary and to provide such information required to accomplish the obtaining of such grant.

**Section III:** This Resolution shall be in force from and after the date of its passage.
