Instructions:

Non-Host Ride-Along Requests: Submit the completed request to the Administration Office for processing. **Application must be received at least one week prior to the time you desire to ride-along**. Requests not submitted at least one week prior to the desired ride-along date shall be at the discretion of the Chief of Police or his designee, as to whether the you will be allowed to participate in the Program.

<u>Officer Sponsored Ride-Along Requests:</u> Submit the completed request to the squad sergeant for approval. If approved, the squad sergeant will forward the completed request to the Administration Office for processing.

<u>News Media Requests'</u>: Submit all news media ride-along requests to the Public Affairs Officer for approval. Final approval for all news media ride-along requests will be made by the Chief of Police.

Background / Wanted Checks': The Administration Office will be responsible for all Background/Wanted Checks.

<u>Rider Signature/Liability Release</u>: Assigned Officers are responsible for ensuring this request/liability release is signed prior to the beginning of the ride-along.

<u>Dress Code</u>: Participants <u>SHALL</u> wear appropriate attire for the duration of the ride-along. This shall consist of casual skirts or slacks and blouses for women and casual slacks and shirts for men. Shirts shall have collars and sleeves. Sweats, shorts, or attire with vulgar, rude, or offensive logos are prohibited.

NIXA POLICE DEPARTMENT RIDE-ALONG GUIDELINES FORM

The work and activities of law enforcement officers is inherently dangerous. Strict adherence to the following guidelines is necessary in order to safeguard participants and to minimize the possibility of interference with normal Department activities and obligations. Participants will:

- 1. Report to the Police Department at 715 W Center Circle, Nixa, MO at the scheduled date and time
- 2. Present a neat and clean appearance and wear appropriate apparel, which will consist of pants, shirts with a collar and sleeves. Dresses, skirts, t-shirts, tank tops, sandals, thongs, or high heels are examples of unacceptable attire. Clothing or jewelry that could be offensive to the public, the department, or the city will not be allowed. Tattoos that could be offensive will be covered during the ride-along.
- 3. Wear no headgear or clothing that could create a perception that the ride-along is a law enforcement employee. This includes police logos, patches, badges, insignia, writings, words, phrases, or pictures, Sam Browne belt, basket weave leather, flashlights, handcuffs, or any other police-related equipment.
- 4. Will not participate while carrying a firearm. This does not apply to individuals possessing a commission from an outside law enforcement agency whom have received authorization from the Chief of Police or their designee to carry concealed during the ride along. In addition, outside officers shall not display any article of clothing that readily identifies them as a law enforcement officer.
- 5. Not possess or use cameras, video equipment, or other recording devices during the ride-along.
- 6. Provide the assigned officer with proper identification prior to the ride-along.
- 7. Provide for own meal during the ride-along if applicable.
- 8. Follow instructions of the assigned and other officers for your safety.
- 9. Not participate in any police action or act in a police capacity.
- 10. Not converse with prisoners, suspects, witnesses, victims, media personnel, or other persons contacted during ride-along unless directed by the assigned officer.
- 11. Not interfere with assigned officer while he is conducting police activities. While you are encouraged to ask questions, please do so at the appropriate time.
- 12. Wear safety belts at all times while the police vehicle is in motion.
- 13. Stay in the police vehicle unless otherwise instructed.
- 14. Any deviation from these guidelines or the assigned or another officer's instructions may result in the immediate termination of the ride-along's participation.
