

Issue: Budget Amendment of \$40,000 from ARPA funds to be

allocated to non-profits

### **Background**

In March of 2021 the American Recue Plan Act was passed, which provided a direct payment of funds to the City of Nixa for local fiscal recovery. The City of Nixa has received the first of two payments. During discussions with City Council, it was decided that \$40,000 would be allocated from the first payment to non-profits as allowed by the U.S. Department of Treasury's interim final rule. To be eligible, the nonprofit would have to be exempt from Federal income taxation as described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

### **Analysis**

In attempting to find the best way to allocate the funds to non-profits, I visited with the Nixa Community Foundation (NCF) about the possibility of their organization utilizing a grant process to help distribute the funds. The NCF board agreed they would be willing to administer a grant process to allocate the funds to other non-profits. To ensure the requirements of the U.S. Treasury's interim final rule are followed, the requirements for the grant awards would be decided by the City of Nixa and would be detailed in an agreement with the Community Foundations of the Ozarks. Once the agreement is completed, it will be brought back to City Council for approval. I would recommend the Community Foundation receive \$10,000 of the funds for administrating the process, and the remaining \$30,000 be available for distribution to other non-profits through the grant process. This budget amendment would allow us to start the process immediately, so we can get the funds to the non-profits as quickly as possible.

#### Recommendation

Staff is recommending the approval a budget amendment for \$40,000 that would be allocated to the NCF and other non-profits as allowed by the U.S. Department of Treasury's interim final rule.

9 10 11	<b>WHEREAS</b> the ARPA was adopted by the United States Congress to address the economic and health impact of the COVID-19 pandemic; and
12 13 14	WHEREAS a portion of ARPA funds have been allocated to local governments; and
15 16 17	WHEREAS the City Council desires to utilize a portion of the City's ARPA allocation to support community nonprofits; and
18 19 20 21 22	<b>WHEREAS</b> Section 67.040 RSMo provides that after a budget has been approved no increase in the revenues or expenditures from any fund shall be made unless the governing body adopts a measure setting forth the facts and reasons making the increase necessary and authorizing the increase; and
23 24 25	WHEREAS Section 8.7 of the City Charter authorizes the City Council to amend budgeted revenues and expenditures upon the request of the City Administrator; and
26 27 28	WHEREAS the City Administrator has requested a budget amendment in the amount of \$40,000.00 for the purposes contemplated by this Ordinance; and
29 30 31	<b>WHEREAS</b> the City Council desires to amend the City's 2021 budget for the purposes identified herein.
32 33 34	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NIXA, AS FOLLOWS, THAT:
35 36 37 38	<b>SECTION 1:</b> The City of Nixa's 2021 Annual Budget is hereby amended in the accounts and the amounts as shown on "Council Bill Exhibit A," which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.
39 40 41 42	<b>SECTION 2:</b> City Council finds that the budget amendment enacted by this Ordinance has been recommended by the City Administrator. The City Administrator is directed to cause the appropriate accounting entries to be made in the books and records of the City to reflect the budget amendment enacted by this Ordinance.
43 44 45 46	<b>SECTION 3:</b> This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final passage by the City Council and after its approval by the Mayor, subject to the provisions of section 3.11(g) of the City Charter.
