

## **RE: Rotary Park Playground Equipment Grant**

### **Background:**

The main playground structure at Rotary Park has been in service since the later 1990's. This equipment has served our community well; however it is becoming harder and harder to get replacement parts to repair necessary pieces.

### **Analysis:**

After working with our playground vendor with the McCauley Park playground and learning about a grant opportunity through our vendor we have an opportunity to replace the playground equipment at Rotary Park. This grant will match the city's expense for the playground making the grant a cost match. This would allow the parks department to replace the main playground structure at Rotary Park with a new structure. This will not replace the playground surfacing which will remain pre-engineered wood fiber.

In order to pay for our half of this playground we anticipate using funds saved from the McCauley Park Playground renovation due to a sponsorship received from Christian County Links. This would allow the department to spend up to \$100,000 for the playground equipment, demolition of the old playground, and installation of the new playground. Our portion of this renovation will be \$57,648.88 for the equipment and \$39,012.00 for the removal of existing equipment and installation of the new equipment. This make the city's portion of this project \$96.660.88.

This renovation would allow for the installation of \$115,297.76 worth of equipment into the Rotary Park Playground. The city's portion of installation (\$39,012) would need to be carried into the 2023 budget as the installation would not take pace until after the first of the year.

### **Recommendation:**

Staff is excited about the opportunity to renovate both playgrounds in McCauley Park and Rotary Park in the same 6 month period. Both playground will receive much needed improvements that will serve our community for many years to come. We are recommending approval of this resolution to allow us to apply for and accept this playground grant for Rotary Park playground.
