WHEREAS, currently there is no cure for autism, though with early intervention and treatment, the diverse symptoms related to autism can be greatly improved; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Nixa values our citizens with autism and their families and we strive to promote autism awareness, inclusion, and acceptance; and

WHEREAS, at this time we take an opportunity to highlight the unique abilities, strengths, and needs of our community members with autism.
