## **Background**

A part of the 2022 capital improvements the renovation of the McCauley Park Playground to provide Nixa's first inclusive and fully accessible playground was a big project. This renovation would provide all new equipment, shade structures, and rubberized ground surfacing.

## **Analysis**

The installation crew arrived to begin the process to prepare the site for new equipment and then begin installing that new equipment in November 2022. This installation is taking longer due to all the site prep and the amount of equipment being installed. Weather has also slowed the process as well. Due to these factors that installation was not completed in 2022 and has stretched into 2023. Crews are still working on this installation and the playground is beginning to take shape. The funds necessary to complete the payment for the playground installation were not carried over, as we had planned on the playground being completed by end of year. Since this work was not completed this budget amendment is to carry over the funds allocated and contracted in 2022 to the 2023 budget for payment once the work is complete.

## Recommendation

With the approval of this budget amendment at your next council meeting the remaining \$530,189.00 budgeted and unspent in 2022 will be moved to the 2023 budget for this project.
