

RE: Ordinance Prohibiting the use of ATVs on City Streets

Background:

In 2018, the City Council adopted bill #2018-087 allowing golf carts to be operated on city streets with a permit issued by the City of Nixa. During that time, there was a lot of discussion on the use of UTVs and ATVs. The council elected to not allow UTVs on City streets and indicated they did not want ATVs used on City Streets as well. There is an ordinance, #20-392, that currently allows the use of an ATV on City Streets with a permit issued by the City of Nixa, no permits have been issued for ATVs based on the discussions in 2018.

Analysis:

During a recent discussion, questions were raised regarding the ordinance allowing the use of ATVs on City streets, causing staff to re-evaluate the ordinance. After discussions with Nick Woodmen, it was decided the best course of action, if Council does not want to allow ATVs on City streets, would be to amend chapter 20, article V, Division 6, Section 20-392 of the Nixa City Code to prohibit the operation of all-terrain vehicles on streets within the City. If passed, the amended ordinance would still allow the use of ATVs owned and operated by a governmental entity for official use and would also allow ATVs to operate for agricultural purposes or industrial on-premise purposes between the official sunrise and sunset on the day of operation. This will be the second reading of the ordinance.

Recommendation:

Due to the safety concerns regarding the use of ATVs on City streets, staff is recommending the approval of the ordinance amending chapter 20, article V, Division 6, Section 20-392 of the Nixa City Code to prohibit the operation of all-terrain vehicles on streets with the City.

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1 2 3 4	AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NIXA AMENDING CHAPTER 20, ARTICLE V, DIVISION 6, SECTION 20-392 OF THE NIXA CITY CODE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES ON STREETS WITHIN THE CITY.

7	WHEREAS City Code currently authorizes the use of all-terrain vehicles on streets		
8	and highways within the City limits; and

10	WHEREAS the Council desires to repeal this authorization so as to prohibit the		
11	use of all-terrain vehicles on streets and highways within the City limits.

13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF		
14	NIXA, AS FOLLOWS, THAT:

16	SECTION 1: Chapter 20, Article V, Division 6, Section 20-392 of the Nixa City		
17	Code is hereby amended by repealing said Section in its entirety and adopting in lieu		
18	thereof a new Section 20-392, which said Section shall read as follows:

25	(a) No person shall operate an all-terrain vehicle, as defined in section 20-1, upon the		
26	streets and highways of this city, except as follows:

28	(1) All-terrain vehicles owned and operated by a governmental entity for official use;

30	(2) All-terrain vehicles operated for agricultural purposes or industrial on-premises		
31	purposes between the official sunrise and sunset on the day of operation ; .

33	(3) All-terrain vehicles whose operators carry a special permit issued by the city		
34	pursuant to RSMo 304.013.		
35	a. No person shall operate on off read vahiale, as defined in DSMs 204,001

47	extends not less than seven feet above the ground, attached to the rear of the			
48	vehicle. The bicycle safety flag shall be triangular in shape with an area of not			
49	less than 30 square inches and shall be dayglow in color.

51	c. No person shall operate an all-terrain vehicle:

53	1. In any careless way so as to endanger the person or property of another.

64	SECTION 2: The City Attorney, when codifying this Ordinance, is authorized to			
65	provide for different section numbers, subsection numbers, and different internal citation			
66	references than those provided herein when such section numbers, subsection numbers,			
67	or internal citation references are in error or are contrary to the intent of this Ordinance.

69	SECTION 3: Savings Clause. Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to			
70	affect any suit or proceeding now pending in any court or any rights acquired, or liability			
71	incurred nor any cause or causes of action occurred or existing, under any act or			
72	ordinance repealed or modified hereby.

74	SECTION 4: Severability Clause. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or			
75	phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect			
76	the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Council hereby declares that			
77	it would have adopted the Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, or			
78	phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections,			
79	sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared invalid.

81	SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final			
82	passage by the City Council and after its approval by the Mayor, subject to the provisions			
83	of section 3.11(g) of the City Charter.
