# **RE: Transportation Alternative Grant application**

### Background:

Funding opportunities through the Ozarks Transportation Organization have been made available to address pedestrian needs in the area. Staff has identified a project in NE Nixa to construct a new multi-use path/trail from Summit Elementary south on Cheyenne Rd. to the entrance of Cheyenne Valley subdivision on North St. This project has an estimated cost of \$880,239.00. The attached resolution would authorize staff to apply for grant funds totaling 80% of the estimated cost. If awarded, the city would be responsible for 20% of the estimated cost in the amount of \$176,047.80.

## **Analysis:**

Identified within the 2021 – 2025 Strategic Plan, Community Safety: Action Plan #6, Prioritize high traffic areas when upgrading sidewalks and crosswalks. Fun & Unique Places: Action Plan #7, Prioritize funding to connect existing school and park properties to the regional trails identified in the Ozarks Transportation Organization Regional Trails Plan. Action Plan #8, Develop new recreation spaces and renovate existing recreational spaces in accordance with the Parks Master Plan to meet the recreational demands of the community.

This project would allow for the first phase of multi-use trails/path connections from the Center, when North St is constructed, and Summit Elementary to the NE Chadwick Flyer system as well as the Finely River Connector Trail. These trail connections and alignments have been identified in the Parks Master Plan as well as the Ozarks Transportation Organizations Trail Alignment Study.

#### Recommendation:

It is staff's recommendation that Council allow for the submittal of this grant and acceptance if awarded.
