

RE: Law Enforcement Sex Crimes Against Children Grant

Background:

Funding opportunities through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) have been made available to address investigations needs in this specific area. Staff has identified the following items a HandScope Laser Forensic Light Source, iGuide camera system, two evidence drying cabinets and a dedicated laptop computer along with a techno data kit for DataPilot as needs. This project has an estimated cost of \$46,616.90. The attached resolution would authorize staff to apply for grant funds totaling 100% of the estimated cost.

Analysis:

The grant request is to provide additional investigative tools to support the Police Department in the investigations of the ever-growing world of sex crimes against children.

Recommendation:

It is staff's recommendation that Council allow for the submittal of this grant and acceptance if awarded.
