

RE: MoDOT/ Coalition for Roadway Southwest Region Highway Safety Grant

Background:

The Missouri Department of Transportation has opened a grant opportunity through the Coalition for Roadway Safety which will provide funding for equipment and/or educational materials that will assist with their highway safety initiatives. This is a nonmatching grant which will cover 100% of the costs of the grant request.

Analysis:

After much deliberation, the police department has decided to apply for this grant to cover the costs of several educational materials. Our department engages in several community oriented policing efforts that are directed at children. We use giveaways and promotional items to initiate conversations about a variety of safety topics.

These items will be given to children to educate them on traffic safety. Studies show children can have a big influence on their parent's driving behaviors. Educated children often point out traffic safety issues when they see them.

Unfortunately, these promotional items can be costly and often we run out of these types of materials during the year. The following items are examples of items that would be purchased with this grant:

Don't text and drive tattoos, NPD badge stickers, Bicycle safety coloring books, crayons, and road sign sticker sheets.

We are seeking \$4,359.60 from this grant to purchase the above-listed items.

Recommendation:
