

## **RE: Resolution for Department of Transportation Grants**

### **Background:**

Per City policy, the City Council can adopt a resolution allowing for the application and acceptance of non-matching grants from the Missouri Department of Transportation Division of Highway Safety (MoDOT) for the funding of traffic safety programs. On an annual basis, the police department applies for specific DWI, and Hazardous Moving Violations (HMV) grants. These grants are a primary funding source for our DWI and HMV enforcement efforts throughout the fiscal year. For fiscal year 2025, we are seeking \$11,500 for HMV enforcement and \$8,500.00 for DWI enforcement.

### **Analysis:**

The above-mentioned grants financially support the police department's efforts to make the roads of the city safer. These grants cover the costs of additional traffic enforcement overtime hours worked by our officers. Without this grant funding, overtime hours worked by officers for these types for traffic enforcement efforts would be limited or eliminated due to department budget constraints.

### **Recommendation:**

Staff recommends approval of the resolution.

16 **SECTION 1:** The City Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to apply for  
17 and accept non-matching Driving While Intoxicated and Hazardous Moving Violation  
18 grants provided by the Missouri Department of Transportation.

20 **SECTION 2:** The City Administrator, or designee, is authorized to do all things  
21 necessary or convenient to apply for and accept said funding and to carry out the terms  
22 of this Resolution, including the execution of documents required to obtain said funding,

24 **SECTION 3:** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its final  
25 passage by the City Council and after its approval by the Mayor, subject to the provisions  
26 of section 3.11(g) of the City Charter.
