

# **RE: Department of Justice Body Worn Camera Grant**

## Background:

The Department of Justice (DOJ) has opened a grant opportunity through the Bureau of Justice Assistance which will provide funding for the implementation of body worn cameras. This is matching grant which will cover up to 50% of the costs of implementing body worn cameras.

## **Analysis:**

Currently, we are considering budgeting for the purchase of body worn cameras in fiscal year 2026. The police department has decided to apply for this grant to help cover the substantial costs of implementing such a program.

The grant has a maximum award of \$2 million. Our estimated 5-year costs to implement our body worn camera program is approximately \$305,000.00 which means the grant could cover up to \$152,500.00.

The body worn camera project has been a requested capital improvement project for many years. However, budgeting for large scale projects such as this has a tremendous impact on the police department budget and funding sources for such a project are scarious. This grant could make implementation of a body worn camera project affordable and a reality.

### Recommendation:

The staff of the police department recommends approval of this resolution to apply for and accept the DOJ body worn camera grant.
