

RESOLUTION OF THE NIXA CITY COUNCIL CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF CLYDE EVANS TO THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION

Background:

Commissioner Ethan Ives recently purchased his grandparents' property that is located outside of Nixa city limits and now resides on the property. Mr. Ives submitted his resignation on July 6th. Residing within Nixa city limits is a requirement to be eligible to serve on the Planning and Zoning Commission.

Analysis:

Clyde Evans has been recommended to City staff by numerous individuals, as an excellent candidate for the Planning and Zoning Commission. Mr. Evans will bring decades of experience as a City Planner to the commission. If Mr. Evans is appointed to the Planning and Zoning Commission, he will serve out the remainder of Mr. Ives 4-year term, which will end in November of 2029.

Recommendation:

Staff recommend approval of Mr. Evans' appointment to the Planning and Zoning Commission.

WHEREAS Ethan Ives resigned from the Planning and Zoning Commission on
July 6th of 2025; and

WHEREAS Mr. Ives' term was set to expire on November 1, 2029; and

WHEREAS the Mayor, based on the recommendation of the Planning and
Development Director, has appointed Clyde Evans to serve the remainder of Mr. Ives'
term on the Commission starting July 15, 2026, with his term to run until November 1,
2029; and

WHEREAS the City Council hereby consents to the Mayor's appointment as
provided for herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
NIXA, AS FOLLOWS, THAT:**

SECTION 1: The City Council hereby consents to the Mayor's appointment of
Clyde Evans to serve the remainder of Mr. Ives' term on the City's Planning and Zoning
Commission. Mr. Evans' term shall begin on July 15, 2026, and shall expire on November
1, 2029.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its final
passage by the City Council and after its approval by the Mayor, subject to the provisions
of section 3.11(g) of the City Charter.
