

A RESOLUTION OF THE NIXA CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE SALE OR DISTRIBUTION OF BEER AND WINE FOR NIXA DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION COMMITTEE'S CONCERT AT THE CROSSROADS SPECIAL EVENT

Background:

The Nixa Downtown Revitalization Committee (NDRC) has submitted a Special Events Permit for their Concert at the Crossroads event to be held at the City owned parking lot located at South Main Street and East Elm Street on Saturday October 24th. The event will include the sale of alcohol.

Analysis:

Section 16-325 of the Nixa City Code requires that any special event on City owned property that involves the sale or distribution of fermented malt beverages (beer) or wine, must first receive authorization from the Nixa City Council.

The event is planned to involve the use of public property for the temporary sale/distribution of beer and wine. The specific location identified for the consumption of alcohol will include the city-owned parking lot at the northeast corner of the South Main Street and East Elm Street intersection. The event will take place in the parking lot, and the consumption of alcohol will be contained to just the parking lot area. The applicant will also close South Main Street from the intersection of Highway 14, south to the north driveway for the Faught Administration building. East Elm Street from South Main to South Water Street will also be closed to increase the safety of the event goers. The duration and extent of the road closures are shown on the map enclosed with this packet.

Section 16-325 provides for several conditions that must be satisfied for the sale or distribution of alcohol for special events. In the event that the applicant fails to receive proper licenses to sell or distribute alcohol for this event, the authorization provided by the resolution shall become void.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of this request.

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-39

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NIXA AUTHORIZING THE SALE OR DISTRIBUTION OF ALCOHOL ON CITY PROPERTY FOR THE NIXA DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION COMMITTEE'S CONCERT AT THE CROSSROADS OCTOBER 24, 2026 SPECIAL EVENT.

WHEREAS Chapter 16, Article IX of the Nixa City Code contains the City's regulations regarding special events; and

WHEREAS said Article authorizes the Director of Planning and Development to issue Special Event Permits under certain terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS Section 16-325 requires City Council's authorization prior to the issuance of a Special Event Permit for any special event which includes the selling or distribution of fermented malt beverages on City-owned property; and

WHEREAS an application for a Special Event Permit for an event referred to as "Concert at the Crossroads" has been submitted to the Planning and Development Department, and attached hereto as "Resolution Exhibit A"; and

WHEREAS the application for the Special Event Permit contains details regarding the organizer's plan to comply with the requirements of the Nixa City Code, including details on where fermented malt beverages or wine may be consumed and sold; and

WHEREAS it is anticipated that said event will include the sale or distribution of fermented malt beverages or wine on City-owned property and that the event will occur on October 24, 2026, and be limited to the north City parking lot at Main and Elm; and

WHEREAS City Council desires to authorize the sale or distribution of alcohol on City-owned property and authorizes the event as a single-day event, provided that all applicable provisions of the Nixa City Code are complied with.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NIXA, AS FOLLOWS, THAT:

SECTION 1: City Council hereby provides authorization to allow for the sale or distribution of fermented malt beverages or wine upon the City-owned property designated on "Resolution Exhibit A," which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, as required by Section 16-325 of the Nixa City Code, for the proposed special event "Concert at the Crossroads," which is anticipated to occur on October 24, 2026. Said authorization is expressly subject to full compliance with all applicable provisions of the Nixa City Code, including, without limitation, the provisions of Chapter 16, Article IX of the Nixa City Code.

SECTION 2: The City Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to do all things necessary or convenient to carry out the terms of this Resolution provided that such actions are consistent with the terms and intent of this Resolution.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its final passage by the City Council and after its approval by the Mayor, subject to the provisions of section 3.11(g) of the City Charter.

Purpose and /or Description of Event

This will be a concert in the parking lot to provide yet another community downtown event and to raise money for the NDRC efforts for downtown revitalization and Sertoma Childrens charities. The event will be a concert held in the north city parking lot. The alcohol containment area will be limited to the parking lot area only. We request portions of Main Street and Elm street to be closed for security efforts for approach to the concert area. Sertoma will be providing the alcohol like previous events with permit. They will also provide security. We request assistance from the city for road closures and barriers. Close Down the City North Parking lot at 10pm Friday Oct 23 to 6am Sun Oct 25. Close Down Main Street to Glenn Street 3pm Sat Oct 24 to 6am Sun Oct 25 Close Down Elm Street to Waters 3pm Sat Oct 24 to 6am Sun Oct 25 Close Down city South Parking lot 3pm Sat Oct 24 to 6am Sun Oct 25
